**OpSPOT's "909-VETS" Program:**

This is a referral service of area veterinarians who have pledged to do spays and neuters at the following prices: male cat/\$30, female cat/\$40, male dog/\$50, female dog/\$60. These prices are for normal surgeries, dogs under 50 lbs. Program goes year round. Phone: 314-909-VETS

**OpSPOT's "TenSPOT Fix" Program:**

Held each spring and fall for a two day period, participating veterinary clinics area-wide, subsidized by OpSPOT, spay or neuter any cat or any dog (under 50 lbs) for only \$10. Limited space available. Visit [www.opspot.org](http://www.opspot.org) for more information. Phone: 314-995-8678.

**Open Door in House Springs:**

Low cost spay/neuter program: dog neuter/\$40, dog spay/\$50, cat neuter/\$35, and cat spay/\$50. Shots are \$10 total for rabies and distemper together. (They must do the spay/neuter to get the low cost shots.) Phone: 636-671-3643

**Pound Pals "Big Dog Fix":**

Any dog over 45 lbs. spayed or neutered for free with proof of low income, or \$15 if not. Limited time offer! Phone: 314-776-7729

**TO LOCATE A LOST PET CALL AND VISIT THE FOLLOWING SHELTERS AND ANIMAL CONTROLS:**

NOTE: Take along a photo of your pet and leave a written description. Most pets are lost for 1-3 weeks in a 3-5 block area. Check EVERY DAY; most facilities cannot hold an animal longer than 5 days due to volume.
